

- 1. Log into FACTS Management Family Portal (factsmgt.com).
- 2. Using the left side menu, click on **Financial**.
- Using the side right menu, under Financial Links, click Financial Home.
- 4. In Payment Plan & Billing, click View Details.
- In Activity Details, click View Payment Summary.
- 6. Select the appropriate year.
- 7. On the far right upper edge of the Payment Summary, click **Print**.

Mt. Olive's Congregational Night at Minnesota Valley Lutheran High School is Friday, March 1st.


The Boy's basketball team will be playing


